WANDA

I'm going to need your driver's license.

Bob hands his license over to her, as she begins to type on a computer.

WANDA

You are aware that due to the high number of rabbits in the shelter, we can't assure you we'll be able to find a home for her-

Giggles BOB

WANDA

Right, well, if we don't find a home for Giggles, there's a chance that we might have to euthanize her. 2044

Bob

BÖB

You're going to do what? Honey, I can't even think straight, and you're those using big words on me!

WANDA

She might be put to sleep.

BOB

No! For the love of God, don't kill her!

WANDA

We'll do the best we can, sir. But we can't guarantee anything.
