TEDDIE ENTERS and crosses to Max. They kiss.

MAX (CONT'D)

START-7

You made it. I was starting to get worried.

TEDDIE

Traffic was horrible. You know, if they really want to draw people back to the church, they can start by giving us our own commuter lane.

(MORE)

TEDDIE (CONT'D)

Instead of a diamond, we could have a

cross.

Teddie and Max cross to a table, pick up a folder with handouts, and find a pair of empty seats.

TEDDIE (CONT'D)

So, are you nervous?

MAX

About what?

TEDDIE

This. The marriage class. We're about to be judged, Max. By god. Are you prepared to be judged? And in that shirt?

Max looks at his shirt, unsure of himself.

MAX

I... guess so. I'd like to think god could overlook the shirt.

TEDDIE

They're going to be asking us all of these personal questions about each other. I wish we'd studied or something.

MAX

Studied?

TEDDIE

You know, gone over our answers in advance. Quizzed each other...

TEDDIE (CONT'D)

Worked out signals. One tap true, two

taps false.

She taps the desk with a pencil as if to demonstrate.

MAX

First of all, this isn't a test. And even if it were, (TEASING) "Cheaters never win, and winners never cheat."

(QUICKLY) Okay, that's your favorite

phrase. If they ask us, that's your

favorite phrase.

Max gives her a comforting smile as the other couples settle into their chairs. Reverend Meadows steps forward and begins the class.

TEDDIE

(LOUDLY) Hi, Reverend Meadows...
