STANTON

Next time.

MAC

I only have a few minutes, sort of snuck this in...

STANTON

I want you to commute Linda Bodum's death sentence.

MAC

You're as direct as I remember.

STANTON

Only have a few minutes, I need to spend them on her.

MAC

Supreme Court denied your appeal. Presidents don't commute state-mandated death sentences.

STANTON

Presidents can commute any sentences they want.

MAC

I can't unilaterally revoke the death penalty, much as I might like to, it's not realistic...

STANTON

I'm not asking you to. I'm not even asking you to go out on a limb-

MAC

-- Really? --

STANTON

Federal Crime Bill, 18 USCA Section 3596c: "a sentence of death shall not be carried out upon a person who is mentally retarded." Congress adopted this legislation over twenty years ago, all you have to do is cite the law of the land.

MAC

It's not that easy --

STANTON

Linda Bodum has the mental acuity of a five year old. She doesn't understand what's happening. She doesn't understand her crime. She certainly doesn't understand DC politics.

MAC

Doesn't make them less real.

This isn't a discussion between an attorney and the President: it's just two passionate school friends.

STANTON

I told her I was going to try to see the President to save her life. I told her I knew you from school and the woman I knew wouldn't let her die. She drew this for you.

He shows her a drawing: it looks like the work of a child.

MAC

Come on, Mike, this is beyond manipulative.
